

Salvation

Salvation is received entirely by grace through faith, apart from any works, when a sinner confesses that Christ is Lord and the atoning sacrifice for all their sin. At the moment of salvation, God takes the sinner out of Adam and places him "in Christ," where you are made the righteousness of Christ because the indwelling life of Christ is righteous. This transforming act included the remission of sins and the impartation of Christ's life. At salvation, the sinner is forgiven, accepted, adopted, and made righteous, given Christ's life, identified as a saint, and sealed by the Holy Spirit in Christ for all eternity.

- **John 3:16** For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life
- **John 14:6** Jesus said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.
- **John 10:9** "I am the door; if anyone enters through Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture."
- **Rom 10:9-10** If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth, he confesses, resulting in salvation.

1. Simple Prayer of Salvation

Thank you, Father, for your abounding love and acceptance.
I admit that I am a sinner.
I believe that you died and rose from the dead.
I confess that you are the Lord.
I receive Your forgiveness of all my sins as a gift.
I receive you as my life.
In the name of Jesus, I pray. Amen!

- **1 Cor. 5:17** Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he *is* a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.
- **Eph. 2:8-9** For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.
- **John 1:12-13** But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, *even* to those who believe in His name, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

3. Romans Road

- **Rom 1:21** Became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.
- **Rom 3:23** For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
- **Rom 6:23a** The wages of sin is death.
- **Rom 6:23b** But the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- **Rom 5:8** God demonstrates His own love for us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us!
- **Rom 10:9,10** If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Jesus from the dead, you shall be saved; for with the heart man believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth, he confesses, resulting in salvation."
- **Rom 10:13** "Whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved!"
